Jack Daniels Single Barrel

Each Bottle of Jack Daniels Single Barrel is hand-labeled with its barrel number, giving whiskey connoisseurs the opportunity to compare the tastes from different barrels. Try to detect the different nuances - a strong vanilla or caramel presence, perhaps; or maybe the toasted oak flavor of fruit drawn from the barrel wood - From *For Pete's Sake*

Woodford Reserve

Encouraged by dark orange color, the descriptions sound sweet but the overall effect is one of pithy dryness with great finesse. Pronounced Oak, softened by Fruity Rye and Gentle Vanilla, a little toffee and Honey - From *The Bourbon Enthusiast*

Jim Beam Black "Double Aged"

Moderately Rich, with layered caramel, vanilla, fig cake, and subtle sweet corn. A very versatile bourbon - certainly enjoyable to drink neat, but you won't feel guilty if you make a cocktail with it or enjoy it on the rocks - From *What Does Jim Know?*

Knob Creek

Bottled in an honest 100 proof like all good bourbons were a century ago. It is aged nine years in charred American White Oak which lends this bourbon its Maple Sugar aroma, distinctive sweetness and rich Full-bodied flavor. From *For Pete's Sake*

Bulleit Whiskey

Initial nosings pick up soft even flowery scents of violets and Juniper; later whiffs identify melded aromas of dried herbs, hay, dry cereal, wild flowers, mushrooms, and spice. An understated whiskey that subtly displays multiple layers of taste complexity. From *Matt's Whiskey News*
